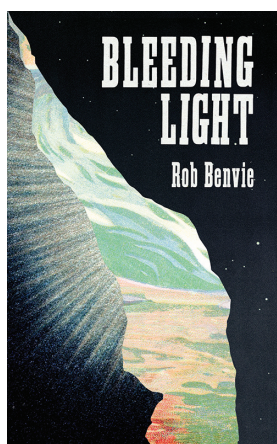


Night Watch | Gillian Wigmore

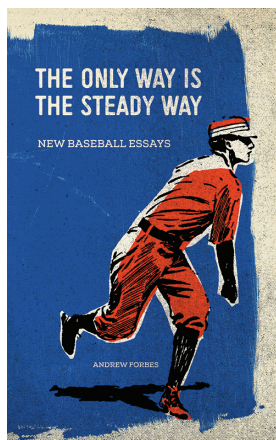


A Number of Stunning Attacks | Jessi MacEachern
